- (ii) Evidence of your writing and analysis of texts; and
- (iii) Final course assessment.

Having a comprehensive record of your drafts will help you to talk about writing, and understand better your analytical skills when diagnosing writing (your writing and your peers' writing). In other words, this writing process will increase your understanding of the criteria for good writing.
